

## Guideline for the security settings in Java using the version Java 8

### Problem description:

During the Java update (Java 7 Update 51), security changes were carried out. Since then, the following error message appears when the PSS-application is launched:



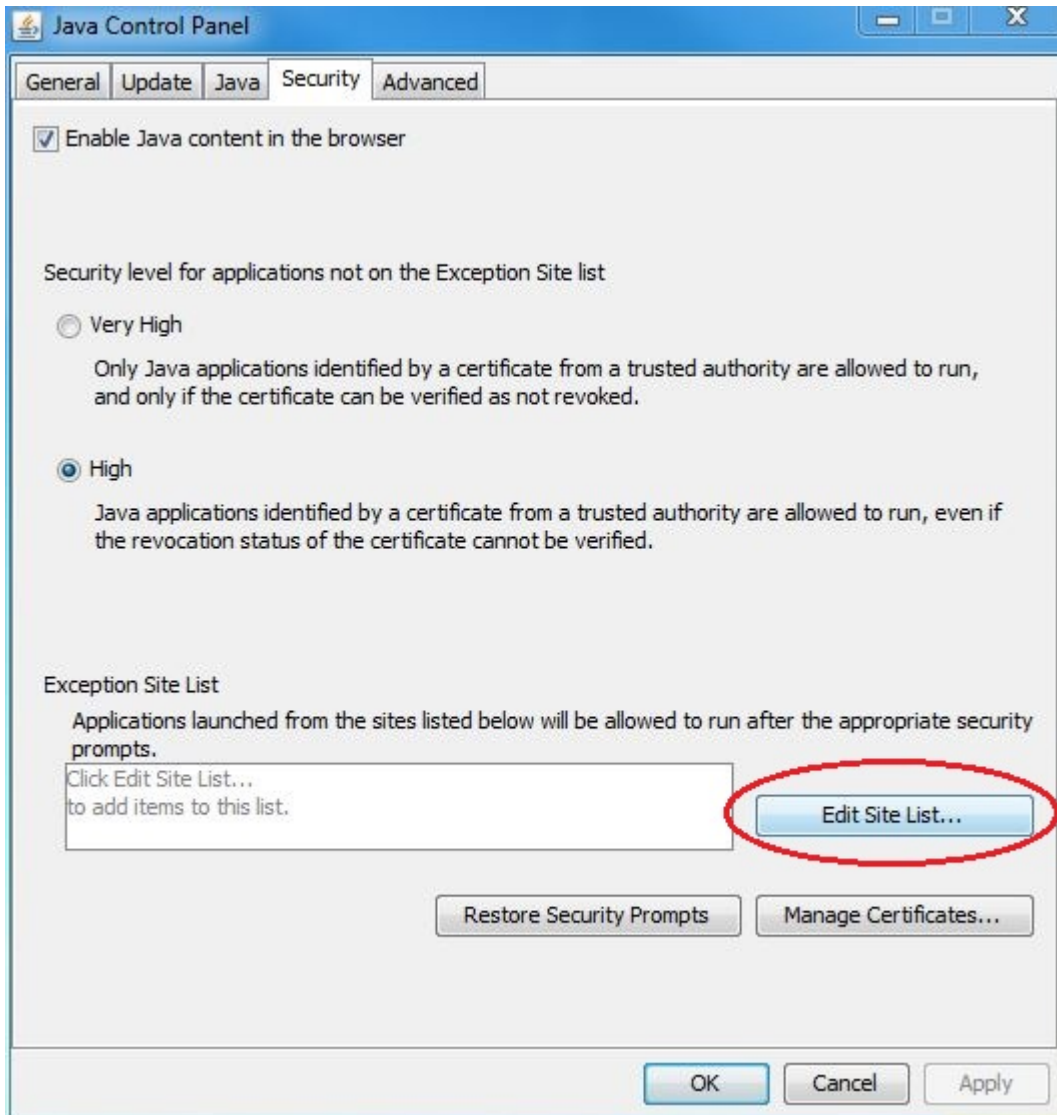
The problem affects the PSS-application download version. Since the update self-signed applications have been blocked. The PSS-application is self-signed, that's why the error message appears.

### Solution of the Problem:

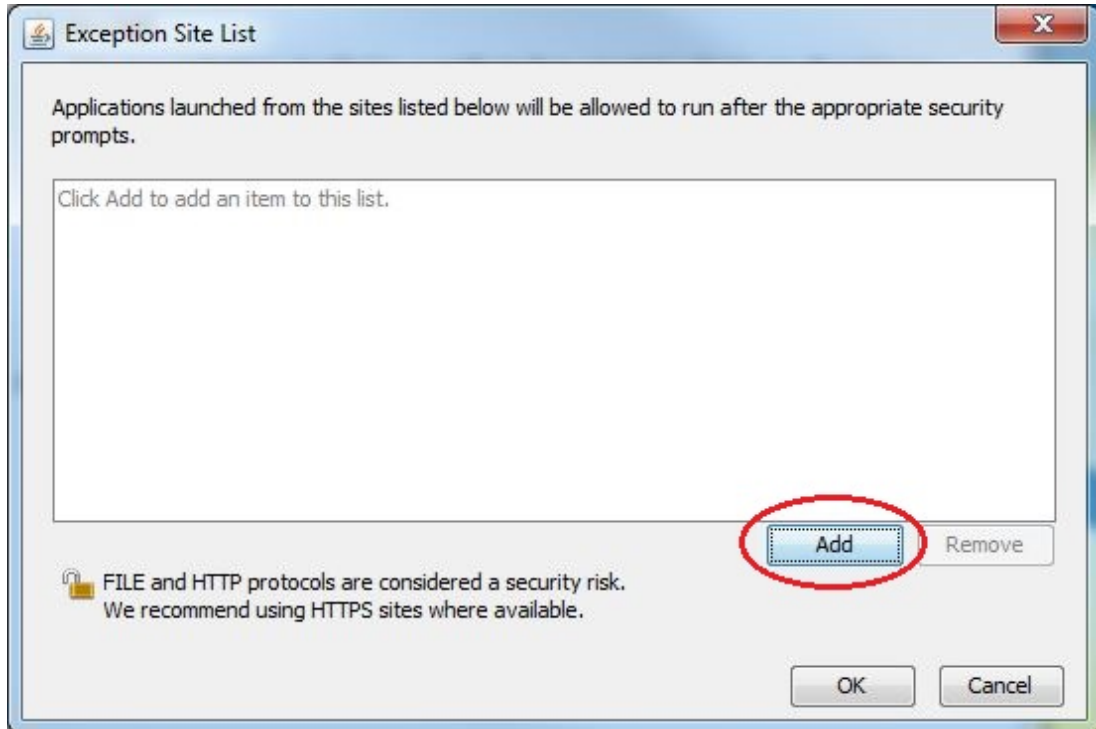
So the PSS-application can be carried out, an entry must be added in the Java Control Panel. This is done as follows:

1. Start Java Control Panel  
Java is listed under programs in the start menu. you can see the application "Configure Java" in the Java folder. This starts the Java Control Panel.
2. Change to the tab "Security."

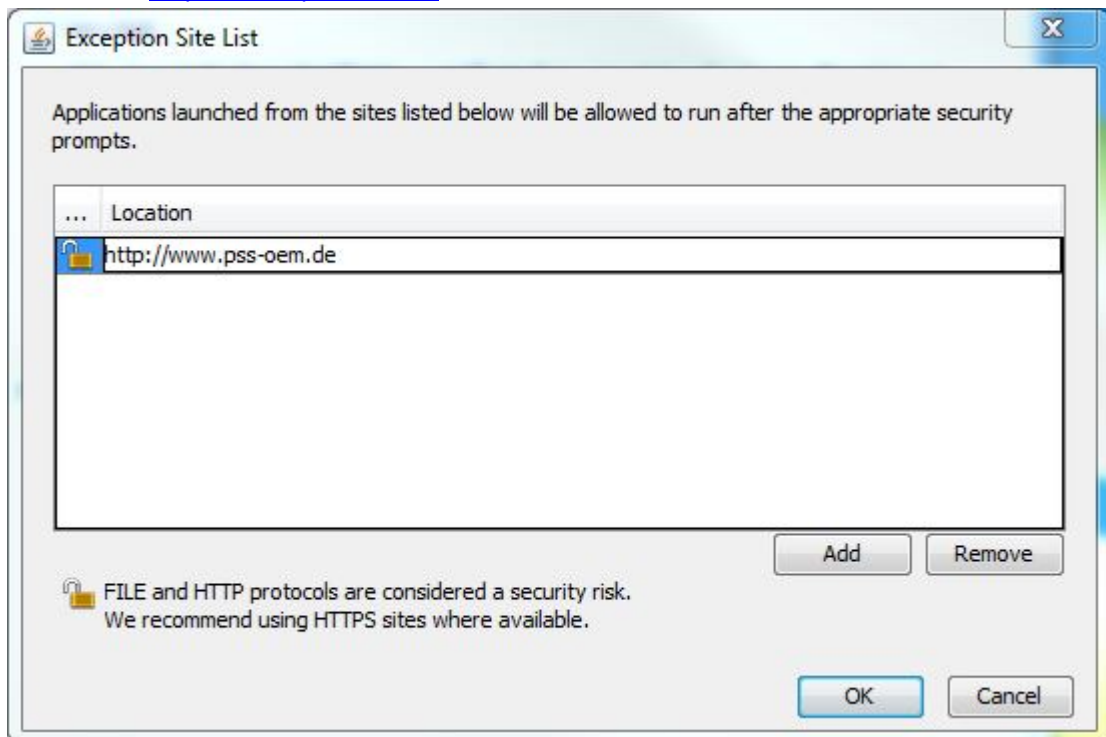
3. The tab “security” has an “Edit Site List” button – click on it



- When the window opens, click "add".



- After clicking on the "add" button, a new line is entered in the field. Enter the following URL in the field: <http://www.pss-oem.de>

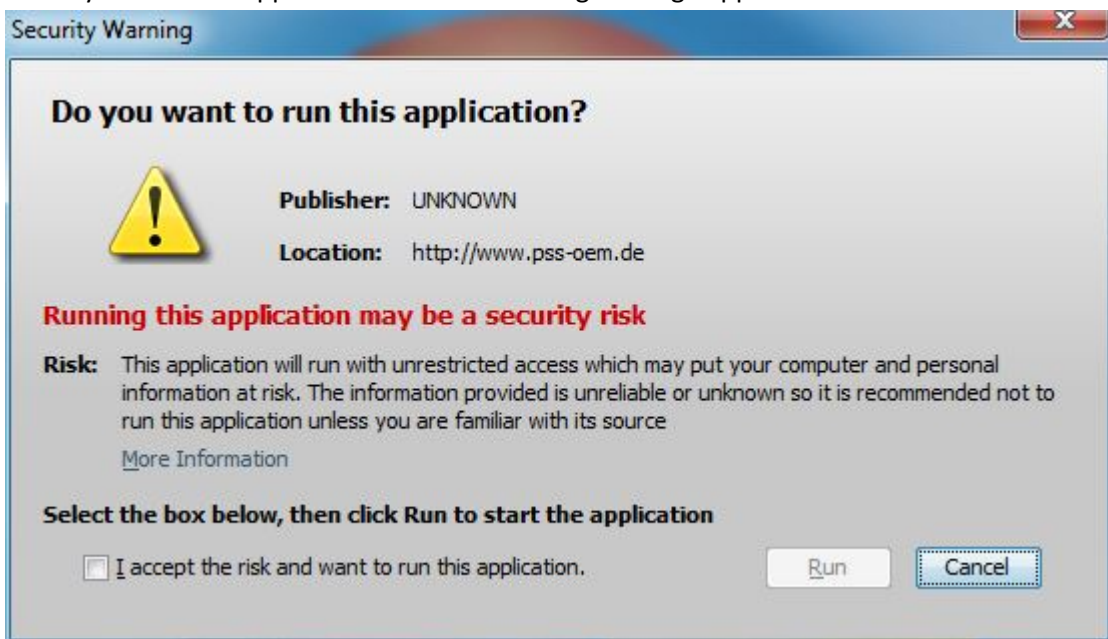


Then confirm the entry with OK.

6. After confirming, a security warning from Java appears. This needs to be confirmed with “continue”.



7. Now the Java Control Panel can be closed with a click on “OK”.
8. When you start the application and the following message appears:



Tick the box and click on “run.”
